## Description

The Sporicidin Antimicrobial Soap has been categorized by the FDA as a Surgical Scrub and Health Care Personnel hand wash. It is ideal for ISO class 6 and 7 buffer zones, as well as ISO Class 8 Anterooms found in hospitals and compounding pharmacies. The soap kills up to 99.9% of gram positive and gram-negative pathogenic and odor-causing organisms. Alcohol-free Sporicidin Soap is non-drying and can be used daily for hand washing prior to donning gloves or beginning work in controlled environments or isolators.

#### Uses

- **Surgical Hand Scrub:** significantly reduces the number of micro-organisms on the hands and forearms prior to surgery or patient care
- **Health Care Personnel Handwash:** to help reduce bacteria that potentially can cause disease. Recommended for repeated use
- **First Aid Antiseptic:** to help reduce the risk of infection in minor cuts, scrapes and burns

#### Warnings

For external use only.

Do not use in the eyes or apply over large areas of the body.

Ask a doctor before use if you have deep puncture wounds, animal bites, or serious burns.

When using this product

- Avoid contact with eyes. In case of eye contact, rinse thoroughly with water.
- Do not use longer than 1 week (as first aid antiseptic) unless directed by a doctor.
- Do not use in large quantities, particularly over raw surfaces and blistered areas.
- Do not bandage.

Stop use and ask doctor if (surgical hand scrub or health care personnel handwash): irritation or redness develops, or if condition persists for more than 72 hours.

(first aid antiseptic): condition worsens or if symptoms persist for more than 7 days or clear up and occur again with a few days.

Keep out of reach of children. If swallowed, get medical help or contact Poison Control Center.

#### Directions

For gross filth removal, lather for 15-30 seconds, rinse, and dry.

#### Surgical Hand Scrub:

- Clean under nails with nail pick. (Nails should be maintained with 1 millimeter of free edge) • Wet hands and forearms to the elbows. • Apply 5 milliliters (teaspoon) or palmful to hands and forearms. • Scrub thoroughly for 5 minutes with sterile brush, paying particular attention to the nails, cuticles, and interdigital spaces between fingers. • Rinse thoroughly and repeat. • Rinse thoroughly and dry with sterile towel.

#### Health Care Personnel Handwash:

- Wet hands and forearms with water. • Apply 5 milliliters (teaspoon) or palmful and rub hands briskly together. • Rinse completely and dry hands.

#### First Aid Antiseptic:

- Clean the affected area 1 to 3 times daily. • For children under 2 consult a doctor.
