FEATURES: Fast-acting and starts to work immediately. Easy to Use. Digestive action reduces manual scrubbing normally required for cleaning. Dissolves, digests, and loosens blood, tissue, bodily fluids, vomit, feces, urine, pet oils, sewage and flood water residue, dried bugs and other biological contamination. Deodorizes by cleaning away smelly contaminants. Loosens and releases organic stains from carpets and fabrics.

ENVIRONMENTALLY FRIENDLY

Biodegradable, non-flammable, and non-toxic. Neutral pH. Economical – makes up to 16 gallons of cleaner.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: Before applying, always test for colorfastness or surface impact in inconspicuous area prior to usage. For general cleaning add 2 ounces of Enzyme Cleaner Concentrate to one gallon of cold or warm water and mix thoroughly. Apply solution to surface or material to be cleaned. Allow at least one minute of wet contact time before wiping or scrubbing to remove debris. Rinse with water and wipe or extract to remove all residue when cleaning has been completed.

DO NOT MIX WITH ANY OTHER CHEMICAL

Removal of Blood, Bodily Fluids and Other Biological Contamination from Surfaces and Materials: Follow OSHA Bloodborne Pathogen Standard, all applicable regulations and industry standards. Contaminated surfaces should be pre-cleaned with diluted Enzyme Cleaner Concentrate solution to loosen and remove gross filth using directions above. Once surface contamination has been removed, non-porous surfaces should be disinfected using an EPA-registered Tuberculocidal disinfectant, such as Sporicidin® Disinfectant Solution, Sporicidin® Disinfectant Towelettes, or Contec® Citric Acid Disinfectant to deactivate pathogens and biological contamination. Porous materials may be sanitized with an EPA-registered sanitizing agent labeled for such purposes.

For heavy organic contamination, such as dried blood, mix 8 ounces into a gallon of water. Clean and reapply as needed.

Carpet and Fabrics: Apply diluted solution to carpets using a coarse-tip pressure sprayer (coverage rate is typically 400 square feet/gallon). Gently work into carpet fibers, then extract using a carpet cleaning machine. Dry carpets thoroughly with fans or air-movers. Stubborn or

heavy traffic lanes may require repeated applications. **Fabric and Spot Cleaning:** Apply diluted solution to soiled area and allow to dwell up to ten minutes. Gently blot and absorb excess with soft, clean cloth until satisfied with results and treated area is dry to touch. Rinse and extract to remove any enzyme or surfactant residue.

STORAGE: Store at room temperature (10-50°C or 50-122°F).

DISPOSAL: Discard used solution daily or more frequently if solution becomes visibly soiled. Flush used solution down the regular drain. Dispose container in regular trash according to local regulations.
